1. Applicant Requirements

1.1 Applicants must have completed high school or passed an equivalent high school standard test or be currently in their final year of high school (Grade 12 in the US system or Year 13 in the British system)

1.2 Applicants must achieve the prescribed minimum score in any one of the following English Proficiency tests:

All scores pertaining to 1.2 must be in examinations taken within two years of the application date.

1.3 All applicants must have a history of good behavior and agree to abide strictly by existing and future University regulations, codes and policies.

2. Admission

The Bachelor of Arts in Communication Management International Programme is authorized to admit up to eight (8) qualified applicants.

3. Application Package

Applicants must complete the application form in full and ensure that all information given is true and correct. All application forms must be accompanied by the following:

- 3.1 Completed application form
- 3.2 A one-inch (1") photograph
- 3.3 Certified copy of academic transcript(s)
- 3.4 Copies of exam results as specified in item 1.2
(Original CU-AAT & copy SAT: please provide your username & password on the copy)





- 3.5 Enrollment certificate (only for those who have not yet fulfilled all requirements for a high school diploma/certificate)
- 3.6 A copy of the applicant's passport or identity card

4. Evaluation Criteria

Eligible applicants will be evaluated on the test scores in accordance with the requirement in item 1, interview test score and writing test score.

The weighting assigned to the three requirements are as follows:

4.1	Score from the submitted test score in item 1.2	50%
4.2	Score from the writing test	40%
4.3	Score from the interview test	10%

5. Enrolment

In order to be eligible to enrol at Chulalongkorn University, applicants must have successfully completed an upper secondary or high school education. Applicants who have graduated from international school in Thailand that have been accredited by the Ministry of Education may use their school transcript or diploma. In all other cases, they need to obtain an equivalent certificate by Chulalongkorn University.
