



**Bachelor of Fine and Applied Arts in Communication Design
(International Program) Faculty of Architecture**

1. Application Requirements

1.1 Applicants must have completed high school or passed an equivalent high school standard test or be currently in their final year of high school (Grade 12 in the US system or Year 13 in the British system).

1.2 Applicants must achieve the prescribed minimum score in any one of the following English Proficiency tests:

- TOEFL (Paper-based) not lower than 550 or
- TOEFL (Internet-based) not lower than 79 or
- IELTS not lower than 6.0 or
- SAT (Evidence-Based Reading and Writing) not lower than 450 or
- CU-AAT (Verbal Section) not lower than 400 or
- CU-TEP (Chulalongkorn University Test of English Proficiency) not lower than 80

Note: This requirement can be excepted for applicants who are not Thai nationals and have resided outside Thailand for at least 5 years, who have completed high school or are currently in their final year of high school (Mathayom 6 or equivalent) in another country where English is the instructional medium. Applicants must present two sealed and signed letter of recommendation from two instructors in their educational institution where they are currently studying or have graduated from.

1.3 Applicants must achieve the prescribed minimum score in any one of the following Mathematics tests:

- CU-AAT (Math Section) not lower than 450 or
- SAT (Math) not lower than 490 or
- Grade "B" in Mathematics at A-Level Test or
- Grade "B" in Mathematics in the Australian Entrance Exam or
- IB (Maths) not lower than 5 (IB grading system) or
- NCEA (Mathematic or numeracy) at level 2 or higher with at least total 4 credits and with a minimum of "Achieved"





The official score report of the tests in 1.2 and 1.3 is valid only when the tests were taken not more than two years of the application deadline.

1.4 All applications must have a history of good behavior and agree to abide strictly by existing and any future University regulations, codes and policies.

2. Admission

The Bachelor of Fine and Applied Arts in Communication Design (International Program) is authorized to admit up to five (5) qualified applicants.

3. Application Package

Applicants must complete the application form in full and ensure that all information given is true and correct. All application forms must be accompanied by the following:

3.1 Four 1-inch (1”) photographs (Frontal photograph, wearing appropriate outfit, no headwear and glasses, no older than 6 months, all must wear the same outfit.)

3.2 A copy of high school academic status certification and academic transcript(s)

3.3 Copies of exam result as specified in item 1.1.1 and 1.1.2

3.4 A copy of high school academic status certification from the applicant’s school (for those currently studying in high school)

3.5 A copy of the applicant’s passport

3.6 A portfolio, consisting of images of your own creative, design, and/or art works, submitted in the format outlined below.

3.6.1 Applicants must submit a portfolio, **consisting of 12 works** and record it into a USB flash drive. On the case of USB flash drive, the applicant’s first name and surname must be written or typed clearly in Roman characters.

3.6.2 The files which contained in USB flash drive must follow the format outlined below.

- A PDF file which contains exactly 12 pages of works (1 work per 1 page).

The size of the file must not be over 25 MB. The PDF file must be named as the applicant’s first name and surname in English.

- A folder contains 12 JPEG files of applicant’s works (1 page per 1 file).

- The folder must be named as the applicant’s first name and surname in English.





- The size of every page on the PDF file is 1920x1080 pixels.
- At the bottom-right of each page, include the applicant's first name and surname (in Roman characters), set in Helvetica 16 pt only.

Failing to comply with the format specified above may result in your portfolio being rejected from this admission procedure.

Note: The portfolio should be posted direct to the Department of Industrial Design (Communication Design, International Programme), the Faculty of Architecture, Phayathai Road, Pathumwan, Bangkok 10330, THAILAND

4. Evaluation Criteria

Eligible applicants will be evaluated on the test scores in accordance with the requirement in the item 3, interview test score and design test score.

5. Enrollment

In order to be eligible to enroll at Chulalongkorn University, applicants must have successfully completed an upper secondary or high school education. Applicants who have graduated from international schools in Thailand that have been accredited by the Ministry of Education may use their school transcript or diploma. In all other cases, they need to obtain an equivalent certificate from Chulalongkorn University.
